Subject: Fire Hydrant Replacement – Sun City Palm Desert Pipeline Replacement Project

This letter is to inform you that the Coachella Valley Water District (CVWD) will be marking the new location of fire hydrants in your neighborhood over the next few weeks. Replacement of fire hydrants will be a part of the Sun City Palm Desert Pipeline Replacement Project, Phase 1. This project consists of replacing existing deteriorated pipelines with new water mains to improve water supply reliability for your community.

CVWD has selected what is believed to be the best hydrant placement and will mark these locations with a stake near the front of your property.

CVWD would like to offer you the opportunity to visually confirm the new location of the fire hydrant in hopes that it is located on a part of the property where it is least obtrusive. There are some limitations involved in hydrant relocation. For example, county fire regulations require that a fire hydrant be placed in the public right-of-way, no more than 500 feet apart or more than 250 feet from any portion of the lot frontage.

Your assistance is requested to confirm the planned relocation of the fire hydrant near the front of your property. If you are unable to meet with us in person, we can arrange to discuss the proposed location and your concerns regarding this location by telephone and/or email communication.
