WRP 10 Field Trip Guidelines

Your Safety is Important to CVWD

This is not an ADA-compliant facility. WRP 10 is currently an active construction site. Caution is highly recommended.

CVWD educators and/or treatment plant operators have the right to remove any field trip participant for misconduct, age, or dress code violations. If removed, the participant will spend the remainder of their time in the training room on site or in the bus until the group departs the treatment plant.

WRP 10 Facility

The entrance to WRP is located at **43-000 Cook St, Palm Desert 92211**. Please note that you can only turn RIGHT into this facility.

This facility has very limited restroom use. Please encourage your group to use the restroom BEFORE arriving.

Conduct, Age and Chaperons

1. Chaperons are expected to monitor the behavior of the students. No roughhousing, running or playing.
2. The student to chaperon ratio must be no more than **15:1**.
3. CVWD takes safety VERY seriously and will not tolerate ANY misbehavior. Students will be expected to follow all safety instructions provided by CVWD staff.

Dress Code

While on the field trip, participants will encounter uneven surfaces, open-grate stairs, and equipment. To ensure safety of participants, dress code is strictly enforced.

1. Tops: long, short or sleeveless tops. No strapless or tube tops.
2. Bottoms: Long pants, capris or Bermuda shorts. No short-shorts, skirts or dresses.
3. Shoes: Sturdy close-toed shoes or boots. No open-toed shoes of any kind, heels or thin-soled shoes (e.g., Tom's).

Recommended

1. Sunglasses, hat, and sunscreen, especially on warm, sunny days.
2. Wash hands after visiting the plant, especially before eating.
